

## **STANDING RULES FOR THE EL CAMINO COLLEGE ATHLETIC HALL-OF-FAME**

Rules may be amended at any general or special meeting of the Committee at which a quorum is in attendance by two-thirds (2/3) vote of those present. The following shall constitute the Standing Rules for the EL CAMINO COLLEGE ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME as adopted pursuant to ARTICLE II, Section 2(b) and ARTICLE VII of the Bylaws of the EL CAMINO COLLEGE ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE.

### **I. Eligibility Requirements for Membership/Nomination to the El Camino College Athletic Hall of Fame:**

- A. Must have competed, coached, and demonstrated extraordinary service or leadership to the athletic programs of El Camino College.
- B. Athletes must have competed at El Camino College no less than five (5) or more years prior to the date of induction.
- C. Coaches who have not coached at El Camino College for five (5) years or more may be nominated and inducted.
- D. No member serving on the El Camino College Athletic Hall of Fame Committee shall be eligible for nomination. Exception may be made with unanimous approval by the Hall of Fame Committee.
- E. Nomination and induction may be posthumously awarded.

### **II. NUMBER TO BE ELECTED**

- A. Charter (initial) inductees for 1988 induction – not to exceed fifteen (15).
- B. Annual (subsequent) inductees –a minimum of one person and no more than 9 people.

### **III. NOMINATION PROCEDURES**

- A. Any interested person may nominate by submitting, in writing, an approved nomination form to the El Camino College Athletic Hall of Fame Committee.

For consideration as an inductee into the El Camino College Athletic Hall of Fame, all nominations, in written form, must be submitted to the El Camino College Athletic Hall of Fame Committee.

- B. Nominees not elected will automatically be resubmitted for reconsideration the following year. The resubmission will have a limit of four years.

#### **IV. INDUCTEE SELECTON PROCESS**

- A. The El Camino College Athletic Hall of Fame Committee shall hold a minimum of one general meeting each year to review nominees and select people to be recommended for induction into the El Camino College Athletic Hall of Fame at the next following induction ceremony. The Athletic Hall of Fame selection committee shall consist of a minimum of ten (10) members.
- B. To be elected to the El Camino College Athletic Hall of Fame, a candidate must receive a minimum of 6 votes of acceptance from the El Camino College Athletic Hall of Fame Committee.

#### **V. INDUCTION CEREMONY**

- A. To be held in the spring of each year.

### **CATEGORIES**

Inductees may fulfill one of the following categories: Athlete, Coach or Meritorious Service.

All inductees must exemplify the highest ideals of intercollegiate athletics and prove to be of high moral character.

If a coach is to be inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame, he or she must have coached at least ten (10) years at El Camino College. Coaching records are relevant; however, the inductee's positive influence on the student-athletes at El Camino College will be given the highest consideration.

Meritorious Service recipients must exhibit a dedication and loyalty to student-athletes and to the entire athletic community at El Camino College.

### **CRITERIA FOR JUDGING**

1. The nominee has attained athletic and academic achievements, accomplishments, and honors while attending El Camino College.
2. The nominee has experienced athletic achievement, accomplishments, and honors beyond El Camino College.
3. The nominee has made an outstanding contribution to the academic and athletic community.
4. The nominee has attained high public visibility and is recognized for his or her longstanding and significant commitment to the community.
5. The nominee has made outstanding professional contributions to the community.
